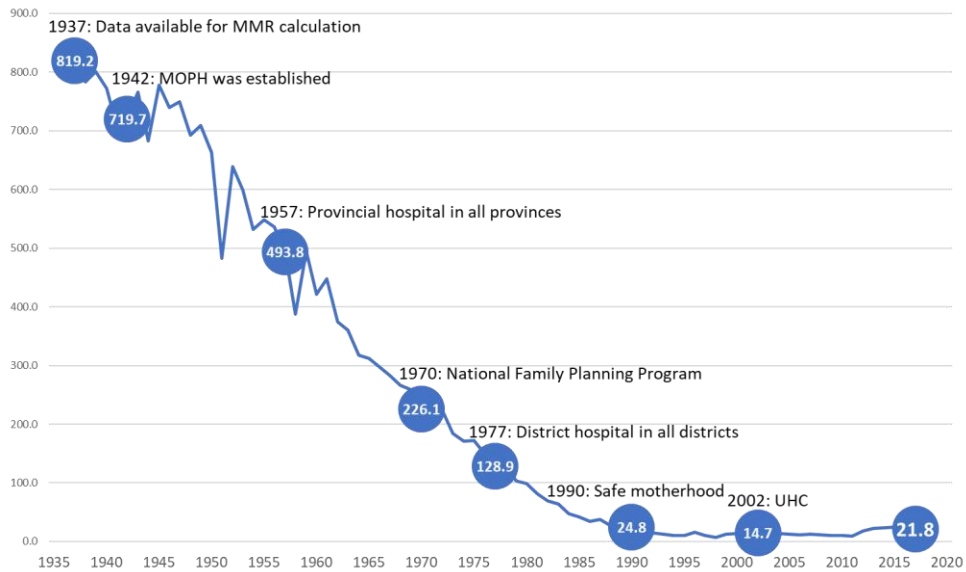

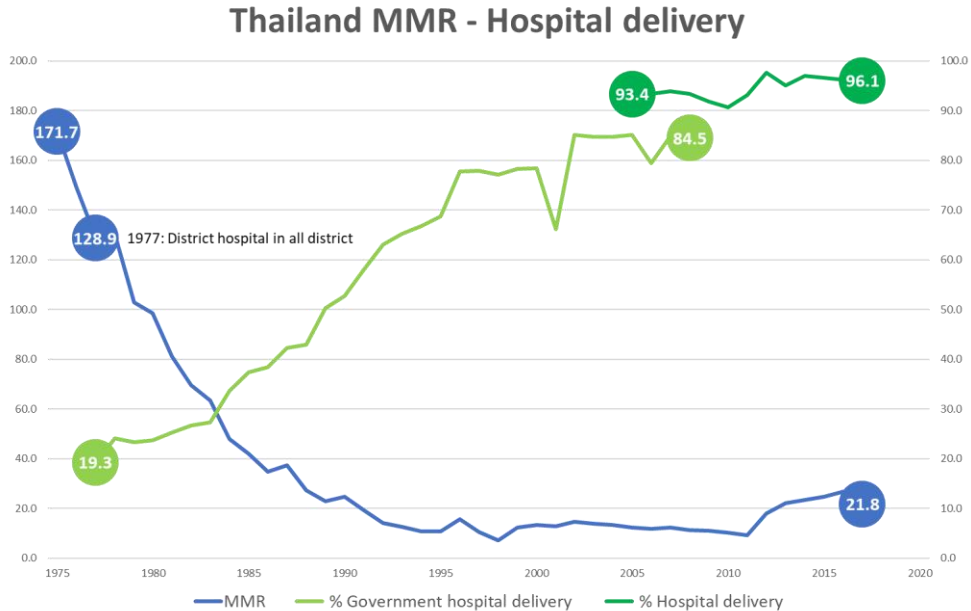

CURRENT INTERVENTIONS

- ▶ **Free antenatal care services** (anywhere)
- ▶ **Quality labor room**
- ▶ **Provincial network**
 - ▶ Fast tract referral system
- ▶ National policy: **Zero PPH**
- ▶ **Reduce abortion-related deaths**
 - ▶ Hotline 1663 : Option counselling for unintended pregnancy
 - ▶ Referral System for Safe Abortion (RSA)

Definition and Rights of Adolescents under the Act



Adolescents' Rights

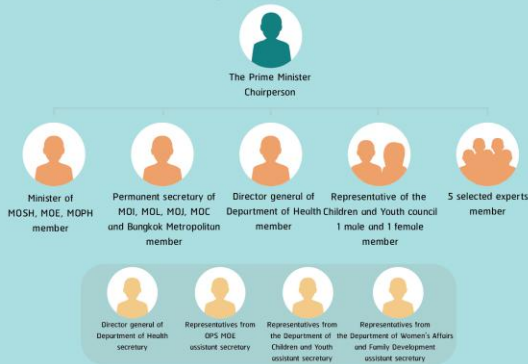
- Right to make informed decisions
- Right to receive social welfare services
- Right to have access to education and information
- Right to be treated equally and without discrimination
- Right to receive reproductive health services
- Right to enjoy confidentiality and privacy

The Prevention and Solution of the Adolescent Pregnancy Problem Act, B.E. 2559 (2016)

A law that focuses on adolescents' rights and an integrated approach to prevent and alleviate adolescent pregnancies

Key Mechanism under the Act

The Prevention and Solution of the Adolescent Pregnancy Problem Committee



POWER AND DUTY

- Propose policies and strategies to the cabinet
- Provide guidelines for implementation
- Propose amendments of the related laws and regulations
- Submit a report to the cabinet at least once a year
- Provide operational guidelines for state agencies and private organisations



Repeated teen pregnancy prevention

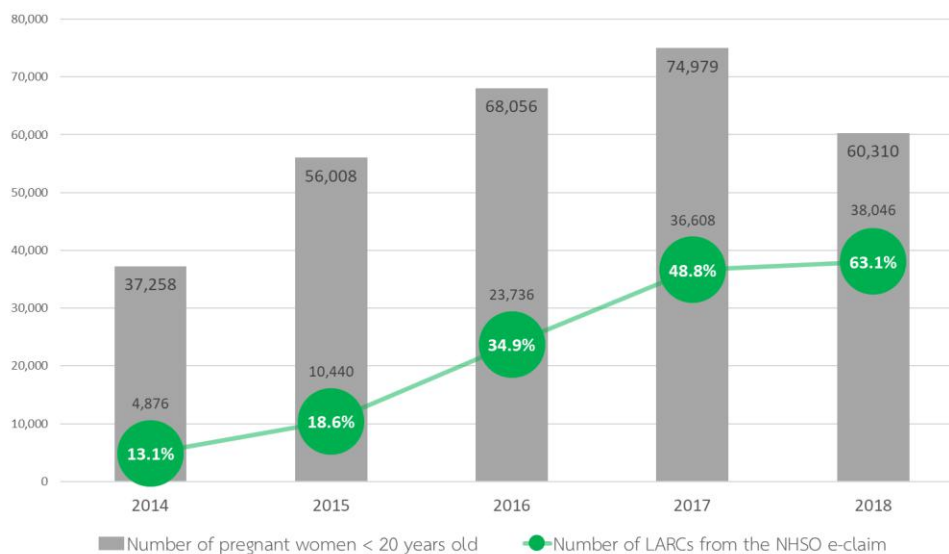
- Provide **free** long acting reversible contraception (**LARCs** ; Implant and IUD) to all adolescents age under 20 years.
- At the beginning, plan to prevent repeated teen birth and pregnancy.
- Then, extend to all adolescents both ever and never pregnant.
- Supported by the National Health Security Office (NHSO)
- Each health care facility that provide services will receive budget to cover cost of services and supply
 - ▶ **27 USD/ case** for IUD and
 - ▶ **83 USD/case** for Implants

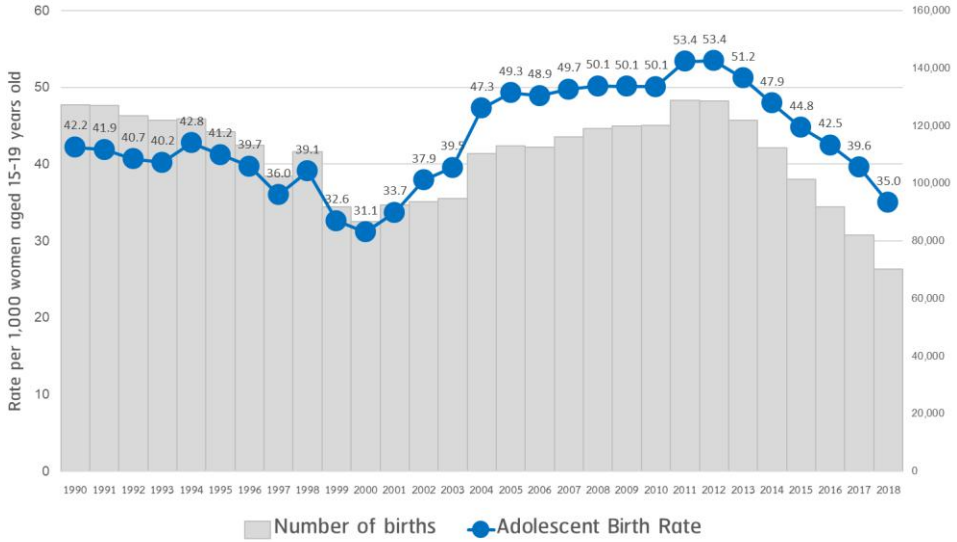
