


Thailand MMR 1937-2017







CURRENT INTERVENTIONS

- ► Quality labor room
- Provincial network
 - ► Fast tract referral system
- National policy: Zero PPH
- Reduce abortion-related deaths
 - ► Hotline 1663 : Option counselling for unintended pregnancy
 - ► Referral System for Safe Abortion (RSA)







Repeated teen pregnancy prevention

- Provide free long acting reversible contraception (LARCs; Implant and IUD) to all adolescents age under 20 years.
- At the beginning, plan to prevent repeated teen birth and pregnancy.
- Then, extend to all adolescents both ever and never pregnant.
- Supported by the National Health Security Office (NHSO)
- Each health care facility that provide services will receive budget to cover cost of services and supply
 - ▶ 27 USD/ case for IUD and
 - ▶ 83 USD/case for Implants
